At Simple Dental Plans we want you to make the right choice for your dental benefits. This is a description of the Simple Dental Plan. It is different from any other dental plan you may have had before.

- · You may use any dentist
- Benefits can be paid directly to the dentist
- Exclusions: Cosmetic; veneers, bleaching/whitening; Orthodontics for Standard Plan

PREMIUM DENTAL PLAN

100% of the first \$300 of eligible dental expenses, then 50% of the remaining \$4,400 eligible dental expenses Calendar Year Maximum \$2,500 maximum benefit Orthodontics is covered for adults and children

STANDARD DENTAL PLAN

100% of the first \$250 of eligible dental expenses, then 50% of the remaining \$3,000 eligible dental expenses Calendar Year Maximum \$1,750 maximum benefit Orthodontics is not covered

LATE ENTRANT PLANS

The Late Entrant Premium Dental Plan will pay 50% of \$2,000 to a maximum of \$1,000 The Late Entrant Standard Dental Plan will pay 50% of \$1,500 to a maximum of \$750

A Late Entrant is anyone who enrolls in the Plan after first declines to participate, regardless of whether the enrollment is at the beginning of any plan year or not. The Late Entrant coverage will last one year from the Late Entrant Effective date.
